Dear Parents and Carers

Further to Friday's ParentMails, we will be cancelling, with immediate effect, all international Summer Enrichment trips. It is highly likely that further cancellations will be needed after this time for other Summer Enrichment trips, but we will delay this decision until nearer that time. The details of refunds for the trips already affected will be sent directly to those families in due course.

I would also like to remind all parents and carers that, in accordance with the advice, you should stay at home for seven days, if you or your children have either a high temperature or a new cough. We are asking that students do not attend school if any member of the family is self-isolating. Please also continue to use the parent Covid-19 preparedness portal and contact form, so that we can respond quickly and effectively to the evolving situation and ensure the safety of our community. For any other absence, please contact the school in the usual way.

We continue to take all other necessary precautions across the school in line with national guidance and at such time as the government issues a further update with renewed required action, or the situation changes within our own community I will, of course, continue to update you.

Since Friday, we have postponed all fixtures and day trips and have sadly also postponed the school production. We have also cancelled school lettings and peri music lessons up to Easter. Arrangements will be made for refunds or deferral of payments that have already been made.
