THEME PARKS OF PARIS

MONDAY 29 JUNE - THURSDAY 2 JULY 2020

Are you Disney mad or do you prefer the world of Astérix?

Students will travel by coach via the Eurotunnel and stay in a hotel for three nights bed and breakfast. During the trip the group will spend a full day at both Disneyland Paris and Parc Astérix. On the final day students will return to Saxmundham via Eurotunnel.

The price includes an evening meal on the first night at a local restaurant as well as lunch and dinner in both park's restaurants during the following two days.

Students need a valid passport to take part in this enrichment activity.

Monday: Depart Saxmundham at approximately 7.00am via coach and Eurotunnel Arrive Hotel in Paris. Dinner at a local restaurant.

Tuesday: Breakfast at hotel Disneyland theme park for the day. Lunch and dinner included at the park.

Wednesday: Breakfast at hotel. Parc Astérix for the day. Lunch and dinner included at the park.

Thursday: Breakfast and travel back to Saxmundham.

THE BEST OF HUMANITIES

MONDAY 29 JUNE - THURSDAY 2 JULY 2020

The week begins with a trip to the countryside around Brighton where students will visit the beach at Birlington Gap and walk on the chalk cliffs that form Beachy Head. The group will then travel into Brighton to visit the brilliant Brighton Pavilion before spending some time on the pier and beach. Back in school students will look at the history 'beneath their feet' by taking part in archaeology activities and completing research for the trip the following day; a day trip to beautiful historic Bruges in Belgium. Here the group will have a guided boat tour of the canals and walk round the historic centre before having some time to visit the shops to buy some Belgian chocolate. On the last day students will investigate the legend of Black Shuck in the classroom and visit Blythburgh to look for evidence of the Beast.

Please note: whilst in Brighton and Bruges students will be allowed to go off in small groups in certain areas (e.g. Brighton Pier and shopping streets in Bruges) and will be under remote supervision.

Students need a valid passport to take part in this enrichment activity.

Monday: Trip to Birlington Gap, Beachy Head, Brighton Pavilion and Brighton Pier. Depart 6.00am and arrive back at 9.30pm. Students will need to bring breakfast and some food to eat in the evening. During the afternoon students will have the opportunity to buy food and refreshments on Brighton Pier, as well as go on the fun fair so should bring some money.

Tuesday: In school activities: research for trip to Bruges the following day and archaeology sessions.

Wednesday: Day trip to Bruges. Depart 4.30am and arrive back at 11.00pm (timing subject to slight change). Students will need to bring breakfast and some food to eat in the evening. There will be an opportunity for students to buy food as well as go shopping while in Bruges so they should bring some money.

Thursday: Due to late return of Wednesday's trip students are allowed to arrive to school at 11.00am. In school activities around Black Shuck and walk around Blythburgh area (leave school 11:15am and arrive back at 2:30pm). School packed lunch provided.

Monday: Day at Thorpe Woodlands Activity Centre, Thetford.

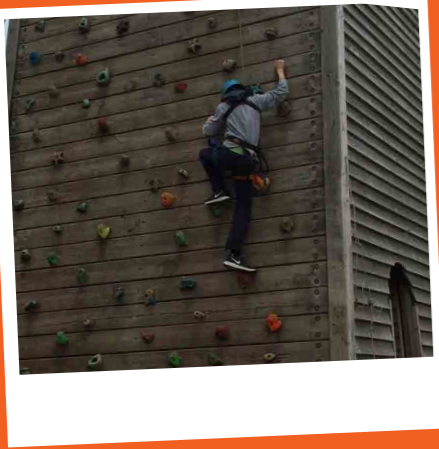
Tuesday: Day at Thorpe Woodlands Activity Centre, Thetford.
