Dear Parent / Carer

Access is now available to your son / daughter's second Progress Checkpoint (PCP2) report online using GO 4 Schools. You will be able to view your son / daughter's progress and access the following information:

- **Attendance** – Shown from the start of the academic year
- **Timetable** – Your son / daughter's daily and weekly timetable
- **Progress Reports** – At the end of each term

The Seckford Education Trust sets challenging and aspirational minimum targets for your son / daughter to strive to achieve in each of their subjects. Though reviewed annually, the targets provide a long term goal for students in terms of their potential in each curriculum subject taught and provide a benchmark they should be striving to achieve or even surpass each year. Achieving these targets would place students within the top 5% of national performance for progress.

In 'normal circumstances' targets are set using the KS2 data your son / daughter achieved in their SATs. In the absence of SATs and National KS2 data, CAT scores (Cognitive Ability Tests) have been used to provide a benchmark from which individual student targets have been set. By way of a reminder, we use CATs testing to take a current snapshot of each student's potential, what they could achieve and how they learn best. How to access the site:

To access the site, enter www.go4schools.com and click on the Parents' icon at the top of the main page to arrive at the log-in screen. The email address you use to enter the site must be the one you have provided to the School.

To request a password for GO 4 Schools, please enter your email address into the First-time User field and click 'Please send me a password'. A password will then be generated and sent to your email address. You will then be able to log into the site and view your son / daughter's page. To see the report in full you will need to scroll to the bottom of the page then select view report under the progress and reports heading.
