Dear Parent / Carer,

Now that we are all going to be back in school we can re-start peripatetic music lessons again.

If you have already signed up and paid for your son or daughter to have lessons on piano or guitar, these will re-commence during the week beginning March 15th. No further payment is needed from you at this time until we have made up the full complement of 10 lessons which you paid for in the Michaelmas term, prior to Lockdown.

If you have already signed up and paid for voice lessons, these will recommence after the Easter Holidays. No further payment will be due until we have made up the full complement of 10 lessons which you paid for in the Michaelmas term, prior to Lockdown.

If you would like your son or daughter to have lessons on electric guitar, bass guitar, piano, voice or brass instruments, **but have not yet signed up for these**, please fill in the attached slip and email this to tkirk@seckfordeducation.org.uk Once I have received your email, you will then be able to pay for a series of 10 instrumental lessons of 20 minutes each at a total cost of £100 via ParentMail and the instrumental lessons will start as soon as your payment has been processed. These are one-to-one, socially distanced lessons with our team of expert instrumental tutors; Mr John Alderton (piano and brass), Mr James Wheeler (guitar / bass guitar) and Mrs Megan Peel (voice). Lessons take place during the school day on a rota basis.

It may be possible to have lessons on other instruments if there is sufficient demand, so do please let me know if you would like your child to learn a different instrument.

Lessons take place in well ventilated practice rooms or classrooms, with the instrumental tutor socially distanced at a minimum of 2 metres. For voice or brass lessons, the tutor will be more than 3 metres away.
