Our continued thanks go to all staff, students and families for your support in following the protocols in place to maximise COVID-19 safety in our schools and wider communities. In-line with information shared prior to half term and Suffolk County Council guidance, current arrangements in school are as below with the next review point Monday 15 November.

#### **TESTING**

Lateral Flow testing is to continue, with students and staff strongly recommended to test regularly each week. We encourage everyone to test before the return to school on a Monday and again on a Thursday or Friday morning.

#### **FACEMASKS**

Unless exempt, students are to wear facemasks in communal indoor areas, classrooms and on transport, with staff doing the same in communal indoor areas and in classrooms if preferred. Essential external visitors to the school site will be expected to wear facemasks at all times.

#### HAND SANITISING

Students and staff to sanitise hands on arrival at school and at the start / end of each lesson.

#### **VENTILATION**

As previously, windows and doors will be kept open across the school. With the incoming colder weather conditions, the wearing of SET Saxmundham red hoodies underneath blazers will be allowed for the second half of the Michaelmas term. Students may wear suitable short sleeved white layers or thermal items underneath their school shirt, until further notice. No other hoodies or sweatshirts may be worn in school, and coats may not be worn in classrooms or when moving around the school.

#### YEAR GROUPS

Students will continue to maximise time in their year groups or key stage groups such as when eating, indoor social times including wet breaks and assemblies.
